Articles with SVHC > 0.1%





• Identical articles as such {o} {o} {o} {o}




- (same SVHC, same material, same TARIC, include individual idenifiers)
- Quasi-identical complex objects 💢 🛱 (common numerical identifier, sharing quasi-identical articles as such)
- Representative article approach () (temporary solution whilst refining tools and data?)

Simplified notification



- Initial idea: referencing for distributors
- Further options:
 - Referencing by "sister" companies
 - By companies with exclusivity rights
 - Conditions: intra-party agreements,
 they must be kept available for MS authorities



• Operating Mode: use SCIP dossier ID as "primary article identifier"

Reporting hierarchy




- ECHA requires information on article level
- Basis: interpretation of conclusion of EU court of justice decision in case C-106/14
- Protection of sensitive information
 - No disclosure between notification and submitter (LE)
 - Identifiers of components will not be disclosed
- Number of layers required work in progress @ECHA
- Further recommendations expected @CARACAL meeting 7/9







Reporting hierarchy













